It's summertime in Linwood and that means it's mowing season. You may have noticed some of the public medians and islands are looking a little, shall we say, wild. It costs the city of Cincinnati over \$500,000 per year just to maintain the public greenspaces in Linwood, which is one of the highest of any neighborhood. Sometimes, the budget gets stretched and the city crews cannot get to our corner of the city as often as we like.

That is why our community council is glad to partner with local landscaping companies to fill the gaps. Our wild grassy medians should be looking much better over the next few weeks. Along the same lines of keeping our neighborhood clean, you may have heard that the city has begun enforcing its new trash policy. We have had the new cans for some time now, but as of this month, you might find yourself facing a fine for failing to put out your trash properly. Make sure your trash bin is not overflowing, and all of your bags are inside a bin. If you have a large item, call 561-6000 in advance and the city will come haul it away for free. Stay safe in the heat, but make sure to get outside and enjoy some of the great recreational resources available in our neighborhood, from a nature walk in Otto Armeleder, to bike rides on the Lunken Trail, or a quick round on the Lunken Golf Course! After you work up a sweat, try cooling off at one of the nearby CRC pools, the Mt. Washington Pool, Madisonville Pool, and Leblond Pool (in East End) are each great facilities within minutes of Linwood.

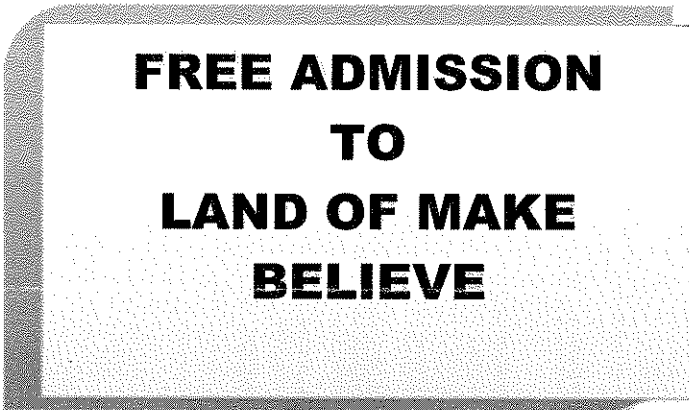

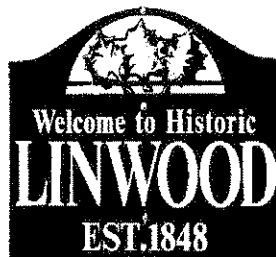
